

Cashback that can benefit your children.

There are many ways that you can support our school raise that much needed money for those little extras that make a huge difference to the enjoyment of school life.

One such way is using cashback websites such as http://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/. Through ordering online on these site to buy your routine purchases, you could be donating cashback to Longton Association which could buy new resources.

Once you have accessed the website homepage, click on support a good cause. Add Longton Primary School and just fill in your name and details and then you can shop as normal except you will be advised of a cashback amount that your purchase will create for Longton Association.

The proceeds of this cashback will then be transferred to the Association Bank account, so it can be spent on enrichments for your child in school.

This is a quick and easy way of gaining funds with no outlay from yourselves. Please have a go, especially for any larger purchases as it really can make a difference.
