<u>Geography Extra Activities</u> In a 2016 survey the countries listed in this table were seen as number for particular things. You have to be a bit careful with how this information was worked out because you can measure things in different ways. But often it was done as the amount of things per million people, which can be seen as quite a fair way to do it. Can you think why?

Can you find the countries and mark what they are number one for on the world map below? Think how you mark the countries so information will be clear for other people looking at your map. If you want an extra challenge, you could try and suggest a reason why the country is number one for something. Then research it, to see if you are right. Only do online research using the SMART internet safety code. This is not an activity referring you to a particular website - so this research is likely to be something to do only with adult supervision. Remember if your reason is not the right reason for the country being number one, that doesn't matter. That you are *thinking why* is more important.
