

Year 2 Escape the Biodome Teacher Guide

Children will love playing this escape the room game. Here are some tips on how to ensure the game goes well:

- Prior to playing the game, hide the clues around the room so the children have to search for them.
- Divide the children into teams and give each team a recording sheet. Mixed ability groups usually work best. However, if you have additional adults to support lower ability pupils, you may wish to put the children into ability groups.
- Show the children the first part of the PowerPoint which explains the scenario (children stuck in a greenhouse). The game works particularly well if you add a dramatic tone to this part!
- Read through the rules of the game and then set the children to work.
- Children may need support reading some of the clues. Some of the clues involve numbers as words. You may wish to display word numbers somewhere in your classroom and point these displays out to your children.
- Once enough teams have solved the clues, gather the class back together and enter the code on the PowerPoint.
